






## Ho chi minh city- cu chi tunnels



#### DAY 1

Xin chao! Welcome to Ho Chi Minh City. You are greeted by your guide and driver at Tan Son Nhat International airport for your transfer to the hotel. Saigon or Ho Chi Minh City is the largest city of Vietnam. It is the bustling economic capital and cultural trendsetter of the country, yet holds the timeless traditions of an ancient culture. Arrive at the hotel, check in & time free for fresh up.



In the afternoon, we hop on to the Coach and depart for Saigon with a first stop en route to visit a family producing rice paper. Share a bit of time with them and then continue to Cu Chi Tunnels. Getting at the site in the mid – morning, your guide takes you first through an introductory video before visiting the relics. Along the visit, you will have the chance to see various mantraps, the remains of an American tank and numerous bomb craters. The next hour is dedicated to exploring the maze of tunnels and to understand better how the Viet Cong survived in this underground network. Back to Saigon. Dinner & Overnight in Ho Chi Minh.

## Mekong delta full day



#### DAY 2

Today we take you to My Tho, the capital of Tien Giang Province. Situated on the Mekong River, 75 kilometers southeast of Ho Chi Minh City, the city is surrounded by orchards and rice fields, which produce grain for the entire country. Visit one or two of the islands that produce traditional handcrafts, coconut candy and bee farms. Visit the VinhTrang Pagoda, the oldest one in the delta on your boat trip on the Mekong River. Return to Ho Chi Minh City.Evening, free time to enjoy the crowded and bustling Ho Chi Minh City – Ho Chi Minh City is the city of bars, pubs & other nightlife activities. Dinner & Overnight in Ho Chi Minh.

### Full day city tour

#### DAY 3



To start a day trip in Ho Chi Minh City, nothing is better than taking the morning trip to visit Independence Palace, also known at the Reunification palace that was built on the sight of the former Norodom palace. This widely known landmark of Ho Chi Minh City was designed by the architect Ngo Viet Thu and built on an area of 4,500 m<sup>2</sup> with 3 floors, 1 terrace, 2 mezzanines, ground floor, 2 basements and a terrace for helicopter landed. Outside the front and behind the Palace are two green parks. In the mid-1960s, it was the largest of its kind in the South and had the highest construction cost (150,000 kilograms of gold).Continue the journey, you will be introduced with the Notre Dame Cathedral. This work is a replica of the Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris with building materials are imported entirely from France. The architecture of the church is built on the architectural style of J.Bourard which is Roman mixed with Gothic style architecture, including churches, bell towers and parks outside. With specially designed, the cathedral can withstand up to 10 times the entire interior church structure. In the next destination, you can see the beautiful structures from the French Colonial times – the historic Central Post Office that is one of the typical buildings of Ho Chi Minh City, located at No. 2 St. Charles Square, Ben Nghe Wardand District 1. This work is built by the French from 1886–1891 and designed by Villedieu architect and his assistant – Foulhoux, which make it has European-style architecture combined with Asian decor.

Followed by the remarkable site of Ho Chi Minh City is the War Remnants Museum that has a vast display of both the Indochina wars. It is a museum dedicated to the doing research, preservation and display of the evidence of crimes and the consequences of wars invaded by forces. Thereby, the Museum remind the young generation the sense of anti-war invasion, peace protection and solidarity the friendship between the peoples in the world. In the afternoon, continue the city tour by discovering the city's Western side. Ride to Cho Lon (Big Market) and ThienHau Pagoda which is located in China Town. Continue to Bach Dang harbour. After checking in the waterbus tickets, and stabilizing your seat, the boat will start to depart. Try to discover the soul of this land - Saigon River by water bus, maybe you will realize many miracles, a more accurate view of the land once called Paris of Indochina or the Pearl of the Far East.Dinner & Overnight in Ho Chi Minh.







## Ho chi minh – Danang

#### DAY 4

After breakfast, transfer to Tan Son Nhat International Airport for your flight to Da Nang. Board your flight to Da Nang – A town in central Vietnam famous for its beaches and bridges. Upon reaching Da Nang, meet our local driver who will help in your transfer to your hotel. Dinner & Overnight in Da Nang.







## Day trip to Ba Na hills



#### DAY 5

In the morning, transfer to Ba Na hills area where your cable car transfer will be waiting to take you up to an altitude of 1487m above sea level. This is the second longest cable car in the world, with a difference of 1292m between the 2 stations. On a visit to Ba Na hills, you will be able to enjoy visits to an ecological park, a theme park, a pagoda, and a mock French village (not including Wax Museum). Accompanied by a tour guide, you can walk the "Golden Bridge" – the pedestrian walkway offering tourist's uninterrupted views of the majestic landscape beneath.Next you will have some free time to explore the park some more, discover the games and other entertainment areas. Spend more time to relax at your preference then make your way back to the cable car to venture back down the mountain to meet up with your guide again and transfer back to your hotel in Danang.Dinner & Overnight in Da Nang.



### Danang – marble mountain – hoian ancient town



#### DAY 6

After breakfast, transfer to Hoian ancient town, on the way, you will visit Marble Mountain and Non Nuoc Ancient Stone Village. In Hoian, enjoy waking tour: Walk the ancient streets of Hoi An, lined with Chinese traders' homes and wooden houses reincarnated as restaurants, cafés, and outlets for local artists, craftsmen and tailors. Explore the beautiful 16th century Japanese Bridge. Hoi An's unique fusion of Chinese, Japanese and Vietnamese architecture is well displayed here, in what is arguably Vietnam's most tourist-friendly town. We will visit the Japanese Covered Bridge, the beautiful Chinese Assembly Halls, the PhuocKien Pagoda, and the local market.Dinner & Overnight in Da Nang.



### Danang – hanoi ( by flight ) with Hanoi city highlights

#### DAY 7

After breakfast, transfer to airport for flight to Hanoi. Our driver will meet and welcome you at NoiBai international airport. Transfer you to Hanoi downtown for check in. Later a visit to The Presidential Palace (formerly Palace of the Governor-General of French Indochina), Ho Chi Minh's house-on-stilt and nearby One Pillar Pagoda. You will visit the ruins of royal palaces, a revolutionary bunker and the archeological site. Next to visit Temple of Literature – the first University of Vietnam. From here, drive to the city center for an Old Quarter, the bustling heart of Hanoi, has been a commercial centre since King Ly Thai to build his palace there in the 11th century. Skilled craftsmen started to migrate and artisan guilds were formed on the famous "36 Streets". Previously, each street carried the name of the item produced and sold there, and many still have the same names. This is a place you must see to experience Hanoi, where you will find shopping and cultural/historical sites all wrapped into one.

### Ninh binh day trip – tam coc – bichdong



#### DAY 8

In the morning, our Tour Guide will take us in the Old Quarter Area, Hanoi. Head the south of Hanoi for 110 km. After 2 hours, you will arrive in NinhBinh. First stop at Hoa Lu, you will have quick visit two temples built in honor of the emperors Dinh Le, their sons, and the Queen... to know why Hoa Lu was built as capital of Vietnam in ending of nine century. Later in the afternoon, board a small sampan to visit Tam Coc which means literally "three caves" (1.5 hour boat trip). With Halong bay type views of majestic limestone cliffs and mysterious caves, as well as countryside landscape like peaceful streams, rice paddies and deserted green fields, Tam Coc really has it all. You will feel the fresh air and peaceful moments, very good opportunities for photo lovers, freezing the special moments and scenery. Then arrive at Mua Cave and start an amazing trek up to the top of Ngoa Long Mountain for watching the spectacular rice valley with specious view of the nature. In the evening back to our bus and then come back to Hanoi. Dinner & Overnight in Hanoi.

### Hanoi - halong bay overnight cruise



#### DAY 9

We depart in the morning from Hanoi. We drive across the Red River delta and reach the coast a little before noon. We then embark on a beautifully crafted junk for an overnight cruise in the legendary seascape of Ha Long Bay. Once on board, we are served a delicious seafood-based lunch, while the surrounding limestone outcrops make for a truly magical setting. In the afternoon, we reach a less travelled area where we will devote ourselves to pure relaxation. The program is not fixed and depends on the time of the year and weather, but there will be an opportunity to visit a cave as well as explore a floating village or do a little bit of kayaking over the course of these 2 days. We end the day on the sundeck as the sun sets on this magical seascape.



This evening, you can enjoy an aperitif or attend a cooking demonstration before dinner. Overnight in a comfortable private cabin with an en-suite bathroom.
